LANSING EASTERN HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ENDOWMENT FUND AWARDS 2016 GRANTS

LANSING, MICH. – Lansing Eastern High School is the recipient of \$21,962 in new grant money. These grants were awarded through the Lansing Eastern High School Alumni Endowment Fund, a subfund held by the Capital Region Community Foundation. The following are projects that received funding:

- \$1,700 to the SAT/M-Step Golden Ticket Incentive
- \$3,500 to the Quaker Packs Weekend Survival Kit Program
- \$3,000 to the Eastern Athletic Department
- \$500 to the Advanced Chinese Language, Arts & Chinese as a Second Language Programs
- \$1,800 to Lansing Eastern High School Operation Staff Collaboration
- \$4,000 to Positive Behavior & Intervention Supports
- \$7,462 to a history class trip to New York

This year's highest grant amount went to a history class trip to New York, led by Mindy Salais. "We would like to thank the Alumni Association for granting funds for another great opportunity for our Eastern students," said Mindy. "The money helped many students afford this educational opportunity and have spread the word that Lansing Eastern offers much more than experiences inside the classroom."
